

A cherry is the fruit of many plants of the genus Prunus, and is a fleshy drupe (stone fruit).


Commercial cherries are obtained from cultivars of several species, such as the sweet Prunus avium and the sour Prunus cerasus. The name 'cherry' also refers to the cherry tree and its wood, and is sometimes applied to almonds and visually similar flowering trees in the genus Prunus, as in "ornamental cherry" or "cherry blossom". Wild cherry may refer to any of the cherry species growing outside cultivation, although Prunus avium is often referred to specifically by the name "wild cherry" in the British Isles.

Sweet Cherries

Sweet cherries are less physically healthy, providing both fiber and vitamin C but not in quantities as significant (to Daily Value) as with sour cherries. Sour cherries contain high percentages of vitamins A and C and beta carotene.

These types of cherries come from Western Asia and Eastern Europe, but they are now mostly popular in Northern America. The ancestors of most sweet cherries are in fact sour cherries. To this end, bing cherries are one of the most popular types of sweet cherries out there.

It's indicated that you consume them raw and fresh, after you've made sure you picked the juicy fleshed ones, with shiny skin. A great indicator of their freshness is a bright green stem.

Hopefully, causing Sonoma County communities to enjoy lower health-care costs, a cleaner environment and more transportation choices. Making Sonoma County a national model for innovative bicycle-friendly transportation facilities and programs.
